Uniform & Kit Notes

2nd Braintree Bocking Air Scouts

- 1] Ruck Sacks - are preferable - no larger than 65 ltrs (55 ltrs small scout). Please note - Kit should not be brought to camp in bin liners - thank you
- 2] First Aid Kit - should contain plasters, antiseptic wipes, safety pin and a small bandage
- 3] Torch - all batteries should be new
- 4] PJ's are compulsory - you will be sharing the site with other Groups
- 5] Lipsalve is essential to protect your lips from the effects of chapping
- 6] Day Sack - should be small, with **two** adjustable shoulder straps and is used for day hikes etc.
- 7] Water Bottle - should be 1ltr capacity - SIGG bottles are ideal
- 8] Hike Boots - must fit / be broken in and are compulsory
- 9] Survival Bag - orange / thick plastic bag for crawling into in bad weather - will save your life - compulsory
